Severe Weather Advisories:

Hanna Advisory 6 - Fri, Sep 5 - 12:50 p.m.

The South Carolina State Ports Authority (SCSPA) is finalizing preparations for winds and rain associated with tropical storm Hanna.

Today (Friday, September 5), the SCSPA Common User gates in the Port of Charleston closed at 12 noon. All vessel work and cargo handling operations will cease by 2 p.m.

Based on current projections, the tropical storm is expected to pass quickly across the coast tonight through the early hours of Saturday, September 6. Vessel operations are expected to resume at around 1 p.m. on Saturday for vessels at the dock. The harbor is expected to reopen during the day on Saturday pending Coast Guard's survey of the main channel. Gate operations will resume on Monday, September 8.
