Holiday Gate Schedule: December 24 Free Day at the Port of Charleston

Port of Charleston customers and service providers please be aware that December 24, 2007 will be a demurrage-free day at the Port of Charleston. The 24th was recently announced as an SCPSA holiday. Containers in the port on this day will not accrue demurrage charges.

For your planning purposes, here is the holiday schedule as we know it today. Please be aware that carriers may make changes to gate operations after this advisory. Close communication with your service providers is essential if you have critical cargo needs over the holiday period.

December 24: SCSPA-operated common-use gates closed unless requested to be open by an ocean carrier. None have so far requested operations. Union Pier breakbulk operation closed.
APM gates closed.
Ceres Columbus Street (CKYH) gates closed.
Ceres North Charleston (Evergreen) gates closed.
SSA Columbus Street (Star/ACL) status still to be determined.

December 25: All gates closed.

December 31: SCSPA common-use gates will be open for business as usual. Union Pier breakbulk operation open.
APM gates closed.
Ceres Columbus Street (CKYH) gates closed.
Ceres North Charleston (Evergreen) gates closed.
SSA Columbus Street (Star/Atlanticargo) status still to be determined.

January 1: All gates closed.
